

The authors of the papers are either members of the Polish-English Contrastive Project or linguists loosely associated with the Project by their participation in the Project conferences where they presented their views and subsequently published them in Poland. With the exception of one contribution (i.e., P. van Buren's), papers included in the present collection have been (or are about to be) published in Polish journals. The fact that most of the papers are not easily accessible outside Poland may justify their reprinting in one volume in a series which has a wide circulation throughout the world. It is hoped that the papers will be of interest to a larger audience.
