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Linguistic Purism: Language Attitudes in France and Quebec


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Chapters 5 and 6 discussing the questionnaire and interview studies have been rewritten and some of the more detailed statistical data were removed. Finally, a follow-up study examining attitudes towards anglicisms and towards deviations from prescribed usages was carried out in 2015 and is discussed in a new chapter, Chapter 7. In general, these revisions serve to include more contextual information, to present study results in a less technical form and to reinforce the results from the earlier questionnaire and interview studies.

Sections of some chapters of this book have appeared as published journal articles or chapters in other volumes. A description and discussion of four of the language societies outlined in Chapter 4 was published in 2013 as 'Les associations de langue en France et au Québec sont-elles puristes ?' in *Information grammaticale*, 36: 33–40. Certain sections of Chapter 5 were also published in 2014 as "Les anglicismes polluent la langue francaise".
