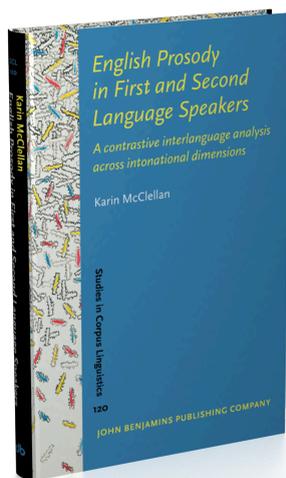

- diacritic used to mark phrase accents
- % diacritic used to mark boundary tones
- * diacritic used to mark pitch accents
- + diacritic used to mark combination of bitonal pitch accents
- H symbol used for high tone
- L symbol used for low tone
