

The series focuses on a core domain of Baltic grammar, viz. that of clausal architecture, case marking and grammatical relations, and the syntax-semantic interface. In addition to three collections of articles the series will also comprise two monographs, dealing with copular sentences and argument alternations respectively. The first volume to appear in the series is concerned with non-canonical grammatical relations in Baltic. The next volumes will deal with a variety of issues in the domain of valency and argument realization.
