New critical editions of his famous lecture series at Harvard University, such as *Science and the Modern World*, *Symbolism* and *The Function of Reason*, his world-renowned Gifford lecture series at Edinburgh University in 1928, *Process and Reality*, together with new editions of justifiably famous collections of later essays and public lectures, such as *Adventures of Ideas* and *Modes of Thought*, will round out this ambitious and authoritative Critical Edition.
