

Notes on the Main Texts

Muirchú's *Life of Patrick* and Tírechán's *Collectanea* are both referred to by book, chapter, and section, as they appear in *The Patrician Texts in the Book of Armagh*, edited with an introduction, translation, and commentary by Ludwig Bieler, and with a contribution by Fergus Kelly (Dublin: Dublin Institute for Advanced Studies, 1979). For these texts, see *CLH* #217 and #28 respectively.

Cogitosus's *Life of Brigit* has not received a modern edition; Colgan's edition in *Trias Thaumaturga* (Louvain, 1647) is reprinted in the most convenient form in *PL* 72:775–790. Cogitosus is referred to according to the chapters in the Connolly/Picard translation: Sean Connolly and J.-M. Picard, “Cogitosus's *Life of St Brigit*: Content and Value,” *The Journal of the Royal Society of Antiquaries of Ireland* 117 (1987): 5–27 (reprinted in Noel Kissane, *Saint Brigid of Kildare: Life, Legend and Cult* [Dublin: Open Air, 2017], 270–287).
