

## Preface

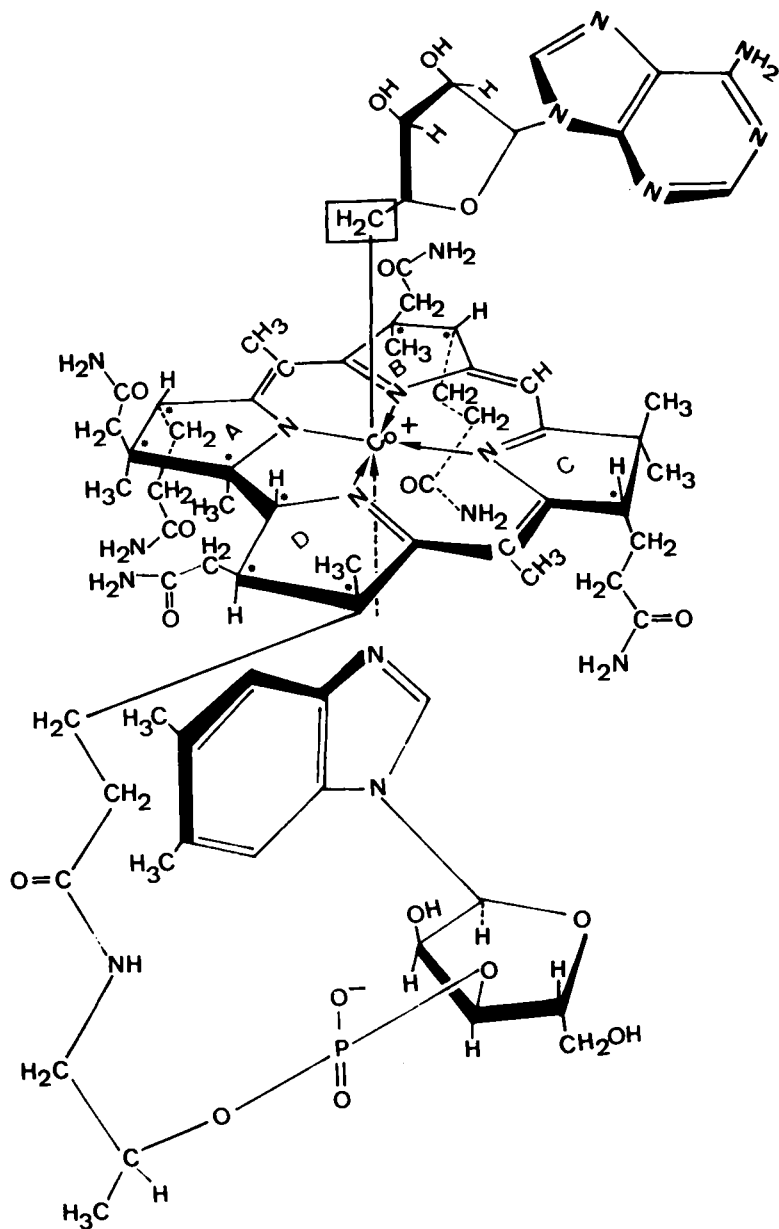
