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Chinese Semiotic Studies (CSS) (<http://css.njnu.edu.cn>) publishes research achievements related to semiotics in many areas involved in the field. In CSS, theoretical academic articles and those dealing with practical semiotic application constitute the majority of the content. Progress reports on current research, discussion papers on specific problems in the field are also included. Articles that look across disciplinary boundaries are encouraged.

Authors should follow the APA format carefully. Each article should have an abstract and should be followed by a short paragraph explaining how the content relates to semiotic studies as a whole. We accept papers of the authors who come from all parts of the world.

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The aim and purpose of CSS is to further develop Chinese as well as international semiotic studies and to promote friendship and cooperation among semioticians in this global village.

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
