## **European Journal of Nanomedicine**

We felt very honored when the European Foundation for Clinical Nanomedicine (CLINAM) entrusted the *European Journal of Nanomedicine* to our publishing house last fall. The Journal has been the official publishing organ of the CLINAM since 2008. It was meant to serve as an additional voice to promote the growing significance of Nanomedicine and its European perspective on it. Today, we want to present its first issue of volume 4, now published at De Gruyter.

The Editor-in-Chief, Prof. Patrick Hunziker (University Hospital and CLINAM, Basel, CH) together with the Associate Managing Editor Beat Löffler (CLINAM) will channel, guide and direct the editorial process supported by Dr. Karin Lason as Managing Editor at De Gruyter. The amplified editorial board beholds internationally renowned, outstanding scientists covering the journal's scope aspects from basic research to applied nanotechnologies.

State-of-the-art hosting for online content is provided on the De Gruyter Online platform (see www.degruyter.com/view/j/ejnm for more information). Volume 4 of the *European Journal of Nanomedicine* came to light in January this year with a first ahead of print article. Once online, the contribution became immediately citable by means of its DOI. Timely speed with which articles are processed and published is as well established through the online manuscript submission and tracking system (Thomson Reuters ScholarOne) – please submit your manuscripts online at http://mc.manuscriptcentral.com/eujnm. All manuscripts undergo

obligatory peer-reviewing. The journal will have four issues per year and shall be included in PubMed as well as many other major abstracting and indexing services. Active reference linking in the PDF articles of the online edition, forward linking, color figures free of charge for authors in both print and online are merely a few of the services offered.

De Gruyter is an independent academic publishing house with a tradition spanning over 260 years.
