Instructions to Authors for Preparation of Manuscripts

Annually 11 issues of the "Journal of Laboratory Medicine" appear, the months July/August as a double issue.

The Journal of Laboratory Medicine publishes original articles, reviews, short communications, case reports and general articles that contribute new information in all fields of laboratory medicine (clinical chemistry, bacteriology-serology, immunology, hematology, hemostaseology, cytology, cytogenetics) in German or English language.

With the submission of the manuscript the authors declare that no paper containing the same information has been or will be published elsewhere or is planned for submission to another journal.

The journal actively seeks submission of the electronic versions of the manuscripts in German or English on diskette in conjunction with 3 hard copies of the traditional paper version.

Conditions for acceptance of original articles

- 1. The scientific results should have not been published before and the author should own the copyright.
- 2. The manuscript should not be longer than 20 double-spaced typed pages including references, figures and tables.
- 3. The following sections should be included:
- title (in English and German)
- summary (in English and German)
- key words (in English and German)
- introduction, materials and methods, results, discussion and reference. The results should be stated concisely with interpretation. In the discussion the results should be interpreted critically dealing with the relationship of the new information given to the knowledge in that field, especially presenting implication for clinical applications.
- 4. Articles which provide a direct contribution to actual topics on the fields of laboratory medicine will be preferred and published with priority.

Conditions for acceptance of reviews

- 1. The subject should be of topical nature and of present informative interest not only for medical doctors and scientists working in the field of laboratory medicine but also for general practitioners and specialists in other medical disciplines.
- 2. The length of the manuscript should not exceed 20 printed pages including references, figures and tables.
- 3. The format is at disposition of the authors, but following items have to included:
- title (in English and German)
- summary (in English and German)
- key words (in English and German)

Conditions for the acceptance of short contributions and case reports

- The journal accepts preferably technical notes or studies regarding clinical and/or laboratory diagnosis as well as case reports or original observations devoted to practical and educational aspects of laboratory medicine.
- 2. The papers should not run to more than six typed pages.
- Format as for original articles.
- 4. Usually these papers will be published within 3 months from the acceptance.

Conditions for acceptance of general communications

- Of interest are especially congress reports, announcements of scientific congresses and meetings, statements to actual aspects of laboratory medicine, reports from other professional societies, from the diagnostic industry, from public and private instructions as well as letters to the editor or book reviews.
- 2. The length of the manuscripts should normally not be more than 3 printed pages.
- 3. The format of the communication can be freely chosen, but avoiding promotional interests.
- 4. A publication is usually taking place in one of the next 2 issues of the journal.
- The Editor-in-Chief will decide if the submitted communications are acceptable.

Preparation of manuscripts

First page: It should include the title of the paper in in English and

German, the initials and last name of each author (in case of female authors, the complete first name should be given), the name of the affiliated department or institution, and the full postal address with phone and fax number of the author responsible for correspondence. Second page: It should include the summary, proposed key words in in English and German, and abbreviations.

Last page: References

Citation of references: The references identified by arabic numerals are numbered in the order of first appearance in the text: do not alphabetize!

References should be made using the format of the "Vancouver Reference Style" as proposed by the "International Committee of Medical Journal Editors" (see Brit Med J 1991;302:338-41).

Example of article in Journals: Thomas L. Wert der Serum-Lipasekonzentration zur Diagnostik der

Pankreatitis. Dtsch Med Wochenschr 1995;120:938-9. List the first six authors -followed by "et al." if the number exceeds six.

Example of chapter in a book: Felgenhauer K. Liquordiagnostik. In: Thomas L, editor. Labor und Diagnose - Indikation und Bewertung von Laborbefunden für die medizinische Diagnostik. Marburg (Deutschland): Die Medizinische Verlagsgesellschaft, 1995:1715-40. Figures, tables and diagrams: The illustrations should be provided in a format already suitable for reproduction. The publisher denies any responsibility in case of loss or damage of originals. Symbols, units, letters and numbers should be uniformed in style and sufficiently large to ensure legibility, taking in account a possible size reduction for publication.

The legends to the illustrations with keys to symbols should be typed on a separate sheet. The photographs should be unmounted and the figure number, the name of the first author as well as the position in the running text should be given on the back, also indicating with an arrow the top of a figure.

Number of copies of the manuscript to the submitted: Three hard copies in ISO DIN A4 and additionally, an electronic version on diskette

Spelling: If manuscripts are submitted in English, standard grammatical English with American spelling should be used thoroughly.

Review Procedure

The Editor-in-Chief and the Associate Editors will decide on the acceptance, return to the authors for revision or rejection of the submitted manuscript after evaluation by at least 2 independent reviewers. The reviewers remain undisclosed to the authors and will perform simultaneously and independently their evaluation within 2months of the receipt date. The authors will receive a copy of the peer reviews with the notification of disposition of the submitted manuscript including the preliminary publication date.

Proofs

The proofs will be sent for checking to the corresponding author who should organize - also in case of absence- their return to the publisher at the latest within 2 weeks of receipt. It must be stated that the page proofs can be corrected only in case of evident printing errors but without major alterations. Therefore, the authors should finally submit the accepted manuscript only after accurate evaluation of the reviewers' reports and appropriate modifications of parts of the manuscript. Successive alterations from the text can be accepted only they do not exceed 2 % of the total text.

Publication

The goals of the journal is the publications of each paper within six months of receipt. The corresponding author will receive a free sample of the issue containing published paper as well as 50 offprints free of charge.
