

DANK

Die vorliegende Arbeit wurde im Oktober 2000 vom Fachbereich Geschichts- und Kulturwissenschaften der Freien Universität Berlin als Dissertation angenommen und für die Druckfassung geringfügig überarbeitet.

Ich hatte das große Glück, im Verlauf meiner Arbeit von zwei akademischen Lehrern betreut zu werden, denen ich – auf unterschiedliche Weise, aber in gleichem Maße – sehr viel verdanke. Prof. Arnulf Baring hat die Studie angeregt und mit großem Engagement begleitet. Er hat mich immer wieder dazu ermuntert, ausgetretene Pfade zu verlassen und die Bedeutung der Geschichte für die Gegenwart nicht aus dem Blick zu verlieren. Unsere zahlreichen Gespräche haben häufig über mein Promotionsthema hinaus-, aber nie in die Irre geführt. Prof. Hagen Schulze hat meine Arbeit mit großem Interesse und nie ermüdender Hilfsbereitschaft betreut, ohne mich je einzuengen. Gerade in der wichtigen Endphase der Niederschrift hat er mir im Lehrbetrieb der Freien Universität still und effektiv den Rücken freigehalten. Immer wieder hat er der Studie wichtige Impulse gegeben, mich motiviert und vor Abwegen gewarnt.

Ermutigung, Unterstützung und guten Rat erhielt ich außerdem von Dr. Niall Ferguson, Dr. Ewen Green, Prof. Brian Harrison, Dr. Hans Jörg Hennecke, vor allem aber von dem leider schon verstorbenen Dr. Vincent Wright, meinem *academic sponsor* am Nuffield College in Oxford, der mir in der Konzeptionierungsphase meiner Arbeit wichtige Ratschläge gegeben hat. Prof. Anselm Doering-Manteuffel und seinem „Tübinger Zeithistorischen Kolloquium“, dem ich im Sommer 1999 einige meiner Thesen vorstellen durfte, verdanke ich im Hinblick auf die Einordnung des Thatcherismus in einen größeren westeuropäisch-atlantischen Zusammenhang wertvolle Anregungen. Den Zeitzeugen, die mir Rede und Antwort gestanden haben, sei ebenfalls herzlich gedankt. Jonathan Aitken, Dr. Sir Rhodes Boyson, Peter Cropper, Lord Howe of Aberavon, Sir Adam Ridley und Sir Alfred Sherman haben mir Zeit in ihren zum Teil vollen Terminplänen eingeräumt. Andere, wie Tony Benn, Sir John Hoskyns oder Lord Parkinson, gaben bereitwillig schriftlich Auskunft.

Dank schulde ich auch Nuffield College in Oxford, an dem ich im Herbst 1998 drei Monate lang als *junior visitor* arbeiten durfte, Merton College in Oxford, das mich von Oktober 1998 bis März 1999 gastfreundlich aufnahm, und der Studienstiftung des deutschen Volkes, die nicht nur meinen Aufenthalt in Großbritannien finanziert, sondern mich während Studium und Promotion auch ideell unterstützt hat. Dem Beirat des Deutschen Historischen

Instituts London und seinem Direktor, Prof. Hagen Schulze, bin ich für die Aufnahme in die Schriftenreihe des Instituts dankbar, ebenso Prof. Keith Robbins, der meine Arbeit für das DHI begutachtet und mir wichtige ergänzende Hinweise für die Druckfassung gegeben hat. Von Prof. Lothar Kettenackers, Jane Raffertys und Cordula Huberts sorgfältigem Lektorat hat die Studie am Schluß noch einmal sehr profitiert.

Meine Frau Christina hat mich auf den Boden der Tatsachen zurückgeholt, wenn mein Kopf in den Wolken war, und aufgerichtet, wenn ich an meiner Arbeit und Frau Thatcher zu verzweifeln drohte. Auch dafür danke ich ihr. Der letzte und größte Dank schließlich gilt meinen Eltern für alles, was sie für mich getan haben. Sie haben mir immer den Rücken gestärkt und es mir ermöglicht, den Weg zu gehen, den ich gegangen bin. Ihnen ist dieses Buch gewidmet.

ABSTRACT

Even today opinions about Margaret Thatcher are still divided. Those who admire her compare her to Charles de Gaulle and Winston Churchill, or regard her, quite simply, as the greatest politician of the 20th century. Her opponents accuse her of having transformed Britain into a country dominated by egoism and greed. Dominik Geppert looks at a period so far largely neglected by scholars, Thatcher's years as leader of the opposition in the House of Commons, from her surprising election as Conservative Party leader in February 1975 until she became Prime Minister in May 1979. These were not only the years that moulded her as a politician, but also the formative phase of that political and ideological phenomenon to which she gave her name.

The study analyses the early years of Thatcherism against the backdrop of Britain's intensifying politico-economic crisis, growing economic liberalism, and the emergence of the British „New Right“. It asks what concept of the individual, of the state, and of society Thatcher's actions were based on. It examines the Tory leader's radically populist and confrontational political style, her intellectual milieu, the discussion circles and communication networks from which she drew her inspiration and ideas. Were there any opposing forces in society? What was the reason for their opposition? How did Thatcher and her supporters react to these obstacles?

Geppert's study shows a society in transition – from Labour domination to Tory rule, from faith in the state to faith in the market, from consensus to conflict.
