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Diverse papers and documents relating to the 1948 war, and to the events of the early 1950s pertaining to individuals I interviewed in their homes, who gave me copies of documents in their possession, for which I am grateful. ORAL TESTIMONIES

I conducted personally over 120 interviews, and additionally some interviews in Nazareth were conducted by Ahmad Mruwwat, for which I am grateful. I began conducting those interviews in 1984. However, the vast majority were conducted between 2008 and 2011. Most interviews were in the Galilee villages Kufr Yasif, Majd al-Krum, al-Bi'na, Dayr al-Asad, Nahaf, Sha'b, al-Rama, 'Ilabun, Jish, Tarshiha, and Yarka. I also conducted a number of interviews in Haifa and Jerusalem and in various other villages in the Galilee and the Triangle.

I also conducted three official interviews with Jewish Israelis who were active eyewitnesses in the events of the 1948 war and in what was written about it: Benyamin Ghonin, a veteran communist in Haifa who fought for the establishment of Israel, and participated, wearing his military uniform, in the unity conference of the Maki party in Haifa; Tsvi

Rabinovich (Bahrav), known as “Khawaja Ghazal,” an intelligence officer for the Haifa district in 1948 in Majd al-Krum and other Galilee villages; and Peretz Kidron, whom I interviewed in his home in Jerusalem (in ‘Ayn Karim). Kidron revealed some details of the attempt to expel the people of Nazareth following its occupation which Ben Dunkelman decided not to publish in his autobiography.

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
