The female figure looks to the west, and the male to the east, toward parts of the world where the Dutch state engaged in slavery. They also look backward and forward in time, to the past and future. The central pattern in the logo is a combination of African wax prints that are popular textile designs mainly in West Africa and its diaspora, and Indonesian batik prints. The wavy pattern is a reference to the (forced) displacement of people across seas and wavy waters. It is based on the Javanese Batik Parant, an S-shaped pattern that stands for several virtues including strength and perseverance in difficult times."
