Arabic words and names are presented in this book in italics in their anglicized form and without diacritics. An exception is made when citing other works, in which case the use of diacritics is preserved where appropriate. In cases where Arabic words have come into common English usage, they are not italicized (for example, jihad). Additionally, the plural forms of some Arabic terms have been rendered into English plurals (for example, *fatwas* instead of *fatawa*).
