

## Notes on the editors

**Dr Adam Lynes** is a Senior Lecturer in Criminology at Birmingham City University, where he has taught since 2012, covering topics from criminological theory to organised and violent crime. He has published research focusing on violent crimes such as serial murder, family annihilation and organised crime. He is also the lead for the Crime, Culture and Contemporary Media research cluster for the Centre for Applied Criminology.

**James Treadwell** is Professor in Criminology at Staffordshire University since 2017, having started his career as a Lecturer in Criminology in 2003 at the University of Central England. He has recently been researching prison and criminal drugs markets, examining the cultivation of cannabis in economically deprived areas and prison-based drug supply as part of a larger project on bullying, violence and victimisation in prison. He is also a member of the executive with the British Society of Criminology, and was Academic Advisor on the Howard League Commission into Ex-Military Personnel in Prison.
