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A key message in most authors' opening remarks is that any errors and omissions are the author's responsibility alone. A further talking point in this case is that opinions expressed in the book do not necessarily reflect those of all participants.

PS: Long after settling on the title of this book, I stumbled on the documentary Whipped: The Secret World of Party Discipline (Public Eye Mediaworks, 2013). Its examination of party discipline in British Columbia is an excellent companion. The film is available online from Vimeo.
