

Disambiguation

backbencher refers to parliamentarians who are not members of a cabinet and do not hold a senior title in an opposition party. Most private members are considered backbenchers.

communications is used in the generic sense and can refer to either humans exchanging messages (communication) or technological methods for transmitting information (communications).

42nd Parliament refers to the period of December 3, 2015, to September 11, 2019.

parliamentarian refers to an elected member of the federal House of Commons or a provincial legislature in Canada. Senators are excluded.

party names refer to national-level organizations or are used in the generic sense, unless otherwise specified.

political party typically concerns a parliamentary party with members in a legislature. Its leader is normally the leader of the private, extra-parliamentary party that fields election candidates.

Prime Minister Trudeau normally refers to Justin Trudeau, who became Canada's twenty-third prime minister in 2015, rather than his father, Pierre Trudeau, the fifteenth prime minister.
