

Note on spelling

The titles of pamphlets and books are listed in italics throughout the text, while stories and articles published in newspapers, journals, etc. are listed in quotation marks. For the sake of consistency, if a story was first printed in a journal, and later reprinted as a book or a pamphlet, I have listed the story in italics. Events in fictional accounts will be referred to in the present tense; this is to separate fictional events from historical ones.
