




Deportation addresses of 41,562 Berlin Jews from the transport lists, counted by different administrative parts of the city (today's urban neighborhoods).
















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




Close view of Mitte/Prenzlauer Berg, addresses of Berlin Jews from the 1939 census (green) partly overlapping with their deportation addresses (red).





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Aggregated mapping of non-matches with the 1939 census (blue) shows large number of moves from outside Berlin into old people's homes (purple).
