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Papers from the Programs of the Round Table on Women's Issues at
IFLA Annual Conferences 1993-2002

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The Round Table on Women's Issues (RTWI), as part of its mission, promotes the collection, research, publication and dissemination of information on the status of women in librarianship. This volume, based on a selection of papers from the RTWI programs, is one of the results.

The papers are organized under the themes that covered the main issues in RTWI's work. The papers focused on the one hand on women librarian's education, advancement, career development and status both in libraries and in professional organizations; on the other hand on women's literacy, women's information needs, women's access to information, library and information resources and services for women, and women's access and use of information and communication technologies. Consequently many feminist issues were dealt with by focusing on women's work and salary, vocational training, status in society and education, i.e., issues of equality and equity. These papers reflect on hardships, perseverance and struggles as they also describe advancements, even victories. International aspects of women's issues are researched in several comparative studies.

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
