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Scope and general policies

Scope

- Focusing on the Western tradition, *Archiv für Geschichte der Philosophie* publishes outstanding articles in all areas of philosophy from antiquity up to the twentieth century. The journal fosters original research on a wide range of topics without prioritizing particular methods, approaches, or traditions. *Archiv* seeks to expand its scope by including more research on non-Western histories of philosophy and non-canonical figures.
- 4 issues per year, print and online.
- While the journal accepts articles in both English and German, most published articles are in English.

Peer review, turnaround times and preprint policies

Peer review information

Archiv is a double-blind journal. Manuscripts are reviewed anonymously by at least two independent reviewers selected by the editors.

The editors reserve the right to reject submitted manuscripts without peer review if they are deemed to lack originality or do not meet the high scholarly standards of the journal in other respects.

Turnaround time

Archiv aspires to inform authors of the peer review decision within 3 months from the submission date. Accepted articles will be published online (preprint) within 6 weeks of acceptance. *Archiv* also aspires to publish accepted articles in one of the printed issues within 1,5 years of acceptance.

Issue based publication

Articles are first published online as DOI citable articles and are later assigned to an issue with final page numbers.

Appeals

Manuscripts that have been rejected for publication will be reconsidered only at the discretion of the Editor(s). Authors wishing to request reconsideration of a previously rejected manuscript must do so in written form and submit a rebuttal by e-mail to the journal's editorial office. Authors should provide detailed reasons why they believe the manuscript should be reconsidered. If the rebuttal is accepted, the author will be asked to re-submit the manuscript, or the decision will be reversed.

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We advise the following approach: Aim for gender neutrality by using plural nouns (clinicians, clients, participants) as standard and avoiding "he" or "she", wherever possible. Instead, please use "they". We recommend

avoiding the use of descriptors that refer to personal characteristics such as age, gender, race, ethnicity, culture, sexual orientation, disability or health status unless they are relevant and valid.

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Post-acceptance

After acceptance, the article will be copyedited by the editorial office of *Archiv*. The copyedited manuscript will be sent to the author for approval before being transferred to production.

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
