- Discounted APC of € 800/ USD 880 per accepted paper (for a short note € 600/ USD 660) available for members of the Florida Entomological Society.
- Funding support and discount and waiver policies in place.
- Authors might be covered by De Gruyter institutional open access agreements, meaning that they may not have to pay the (full) APC.

Article processing charges

To sustain the publication of our fully refereed open access (OA) journal, each article accepted for publication in Florida Entomologist is subject to an article processing charge (APC) of € 1,000/ USD 1,100 (for a short note € 800/ USD 880). There are no submission charges.

Members of the Florida Entomological Society are entitled to a discounted APC of € 800/ USD 880 per accepted paper (for a short note € 600/ USD 660).

The fee is used to cover the costs of the peer review process, professional typesetting, and copyediting, as well as online hosting, long-term preservation, abstracting and indexing, and promotion to potential readers.

Editorial independence

Reviewers are not involved in the author payment process and do not discuss charges with authors. The ability to pay does not influence whether a manuscript is accepted for publication.

Payment process

We have partnered with RightsLink (provided by Copyright Clearance Center) to organize the payments of APCs. The payment can be made in EUR, USD, or GBP, and might be subject to VAT if applicable.

Publication fees are payable upon article acceptance. An APC payment link will be sent to the corresponding author at acceptance. Please note that the publication cannot proceed until payment has been received.

Funding support and waiver policies

We firmly believe that the quality of articles, not an author's financial capacity, should be the primary consideration for journals when publishing. The lack of funding should not be a barrier to publishing with us. Within our fully gold APC journal portfolio, we offer the following support for authors:

- Discounts and waivers for authors affiliated with institutions that have an agreement with DeGruyter
- Discounts and waivers for authors coming from low or lower-middle income countries
- Discretionary discounts and waivers on a case-by-case basis
