The American Statistical Association has invited nominations and applications for the position of Co-Editor of the *Journal of Quantitative Analysis in Sports (JQAS)*.

JQAS publishes timely, high-quality peer-reviewed research on the quantitative aspects of professional and amateur sports, including collegiate and Olympic competition. The scope of application reflects the increasing demand for novel methods to analyze and understand data in the growing field of sports analytics. Articles come from a wide variety of sports and diverse perspectives, and address topics such as game outcome models, measurement and evaluation of player performance, tournament structure, analysis of rules and adjudication, within-game strategy, analysis of sporting technologies, and player and team ranking methods. The journal has an impact factor of 1.0 and a five-year impact factor of 1.3.

All submissions are rigorously refereed using a double-anonymous peer-review process.

The Co-Editors, using DeGruyter's online manuscript tracking system, review manuscript submissions, select papers for peer review, and assign manuscripts to associate editors to carry out the refereeing process. Authors are responsible for producing their own articles.

JQAS receives about 200 submissions a year, and publishes four issues per year.

The new Co-Editor will serve a four-year term from January 1, 2026 through December 31, 2029. The current editor's term continues through December 31, 2027, at which point a new Co-Editor will be appointed to serve from January 1, 2028 through December 31, 2031. In this way, each Co-Editor serves a full four-year term, and the terms are staggered so that there is always a two-year period of overlap between the outgoing and incoming Co-Editors.

Nominations and applications should be sent to <u>eric@amstat.org</u>. Once received, these will be presented to the Chair of the *JQAS* Editor search committee for further consideration. Interested individuals are encouraged to nominate themselves. Please submit nominations and applications by **November 7, 2025.**

Applications should include a CV, names of 3 references, and letter of interest in the position including a brief statement of the candidate's vision for the publication, directions the candidate would pursue and contributions she or he would make if selected as editor.
